Four girls received a micro loan to purchase a Sewing Machine; but also I bought a pair of cattle for each of them to engage them in raising animals that will enable them to sell the products, pay for the machine and give back a pair to the program in sort of revolving funds. Those in Pastry / Baking department were given needed materials to start baking beside the pair of cattle. I see here Mission Initiatives changing people lives oppressed by poverty!



I have hired a cattle man to advise the graduates.

On the other hand, you may remember when I started the ministry to girls ex-fighters, victims of rape who have turned to prostitution in Kakata. It was with little funds. With the eyes of faith in Christ, I am thankful for reaching the end of the cycle with your help. What a joy to see some of these girls who persevered in training of several modules that included AIDS Awareness, Education and Prevention... to happily march during graduation at CESPRO.



My prayer is to see them engaged in micro business that will really take them off the streets. It is through your embrace that their lives can change definitively.

At the Brighter Future Children Rescue Center, Ex-combatant boys and girls underwent series of training and those with high performance were selected for graduation.

My joy was to see those who were known destroyers, killers, murders to carry on discussion, teachings, testimonies about forgiveness, peace, reconciliation in the communities and implemented a huge bill board under the “Peace Builders Clubs”; a module of our training with Ex-combatants.
